' "Love Makes a Family" has been an "exceeds expectations" success as an exhibit at University Presbyterian Church these past two months and we feel fortunate to have been able to mount in in our gallery in the Christian Education building.

We hung all but one of the photos in the galley and put the last one in the narthex of the church to remind churchgoers to go see it. We printed a booklet of the main text: that is, we didn't try to hang the long descriptions/explanations. We did hang the shorter quotes placards with the photos and everyone saw those while most picked up the booklet, and some took the booklet home.
